

# MUMC ADVENTURE GRANT

---

Looking for an adventure that's a little bit different? Planning for your next personal challenge? Then why not get a team organised and apply for the MUMC Adventure Grant!

The MUMC Adventure Grant has been created as a further way for MUMC to encourage and support members in aspiring to more adventurous objectives, pushing their limits and developing their skills. The grant aims to assist with the financial difficulties of such expeditions, helping great ideas reach fruition.

MUMC will award up to a maximum of \$2000 per year, to successful team/s of 2 or more current MUMC members.

## PROMOTIONAL EXPECTATIONS

---

It is expected that any team awarded the MUMC Adventure Grant will

- Document the adventure using photographs/video/etc. and Melbourne University and/or MUMC logo's will be displayed (ie. with banners, stickers or clothing)
- Provide any media (eg. photographs, videos) from the adventure to MUMC to be used for advertising and promotional purposes
- Contribute an article to be published in the Mountaineer and other media
- Provide a presentation about their adventure for MUMC members with the possibility of also providing a public presentation

## APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS

---

Every team is required to submit the following:

- Application form & waiver, completed by ALL team members
- Adventure proposal outlining the adventure you plan to undertake and explaining how it addresses the selection criteria on the following page. It should be clearly identifiable with your team leader's name, and submitted as a single document. Maximum 500 words.

Note: Applications that omit any of these items will not be considered.

Late submissions will be considered IF there is remaining funding AFTER considering timely submissions.

## SELECTION CRITERIA

---

Please prepare your proposal with the following three selection criteria in mind.

### **Awesomeness of Idea**

How does your proposal capture a sense of adventure and discovery? Selection will take into account factors such as difficulty, novelty, creativity and boldness.

### **Clarity**

How much thought and preparation has gone into planning the adventure as well as the grant proposal? While it's not expected every detail will be planned, a reasonable idea and level of specifics of how the adventure will be carried out is expected, including how you envision spending the grant money.

### **Environmental, social and educational implications and considerations**

Please identify any environmental, social, and educational implications of, or considerations you made in, drafting your proposal. This may include conservation considerations i.e. undertaking to carry poo pots on an alpine adventure, or likely educational outcomes such as skills sets your party intends to gain prior to (or as a result of) your adventure etc.

Applications will be judged by the current MUMC committee (excluding any applicants) based upon the above criteria.
